NEXT STEPS

Applying to university for September 2024

If you hope to start university this September but haven't applied yet, you can apply via the UCAS Hub until 6pm on 30 June 2024. Applications received after this date will automatically be entered into Clearing.

If you've already applied to university for September 2024 but haven't received any offers, or you've changed your mind about the course you'd like to study, you can add another choice via UCAS Extra.













Applying to university for September 2025

If you're applying to university for September 2025, here are some important dates for your calendar:

- **14 May 2024** – You can start your application for September 2025 entry on the UCAS Hub.
- **03 September 2024** – Completed undergraduate applications can be submitted via the UCAS Hub from Tuesday 03 September.
- **15 October 2024** – The deadline for applications to Oxford, Cambridge and most courses in medicine, dentistry, and veterinary medicine/science.
- **29 January 2025** – The UCAS Equal consideration deadline for most undergraduate courses.
