<p>All students need to be aware that they will incur additional costs whilst on programme. The list below will provide you with an overview of possible additional costs.</p> <p>Books are reviewed annually and are therefore subject to change, course welcome information will provide you with an indicative list for the year.</p>	
Books and Journals	
<p>Books and Journals are available via the university library / online. Students may choose to buy books from the reading list (not compulsory) - approximately £100-£200 a year on text books although this cost can be reduced considerably by sourcing second hand copies of books.</p>	
Stationery	
<p>Stationery for your own personal use (pens, papers and folders, etc.).</p> <p>Whilst you will choose how much you need, expect to pay around £30 - £40 per year for these.</p>	
Equipment	
<p>As a flexible learning programme the student will need to have access to the internet (computer / tablet) in order to access the online modules and for electronic submission of assignments.</p>	
Travel	
<p>This programme is designed to be studied from a distance. Students will need to budget for travel to / from the University Campus if they opt to attend face to face workshops or tutorials - costs will vary depending on where the student travels from.</p>
