The space allows students across the Institute of Health to engage in fully immersive simulations that can take them anywhere – from the home of a 70-year-old dementia patient to the site of a motorway accident – within seconds.

How to accept a university offer

If you've received all your offers and you've decided you'd like to join us at Cumbria this September, you can make us your firm choice by logging into the UCAS Hub.

If you are replying to an unconditional offer, then accepting the offer will confirm your place on the course! If you are replying to a conditional offer, then you will also need to select an insurance choice. Once you get your results in August, your place at Cumbria will be confirmed.

Read the conditions of your offer carefully

Before you reply to a conditional offer, make sure you have a clear understanding of what the university requires from you. If you're uncertain about anything, get in touch with the university and ask them to clarify the conditions.

Talk through your decision

If you're trying to decide which offers to accept, speak to your family, friends and teachers about what you're thinking as they might provide perspectives you haven't considered before. At Cumbria, we're happy to answer any questions you have about your offer. You can also speak to current students to find out more about what it's like to be part of our community.
