





Key dates for September 2025 applications

If you're applying to university for September 2025, here are some important dates for your calendar:

- 03 September 2024 Completed undergraduate applications can be submitted via the UCAS Hub from Tuesday 03 September.
- **15 October 2024** The deadline for applications to Oxford, Cambridge and most courses in medicine, dentistry, and veterinary medicine/science.
- 29 January 2025 The UCAS Equal consideration deadline for most undergraduate courses.

Writing your personal statement

This is the only part of your UCAS application where you can write in your own style – it's your chance to tell universities and colleges why you'd like to study with them, and what skills and experience you have. It's got to be at least 1,000 characters long, but you have up to 4,000 characters/47 lines.

If you're applying to university via your school or college, they will likely ask you to submit your personal statement to a tutor or teacher for review. If there's an internal deadline for this, make sure you know what this is so you have plenty of time to read their feedback and make any recommended changes.


